

## REM Junior Research Pre-print: Regulation

The REM Junior Research Pre-print series includes short documents in the form of short articles. The major aim of this series is to promote high-quality research at the BA and Master's curricular units level within the scientific areas of REM. Documents of a theoretical nature in actuarial science, applied economics, complexity, econometrics, financial economics, macroeconomics, mathematics, microeconomics, operations research, statistics, as well as empirical applications, especially those in the area of Economics, Management, and Finance, are eligible.

Conditions required:

All papers must

- involve an individual or group work developed in the framework of a curricular unit (BA or Master level) under the responsibility of an integrated member of REM. Papers are submitted by students, preceding an invitation of a REM integrated member.
- have the form of a standard academic article in terms of structure (including an abstract of no more than 100 words and a list of up to 5 keywords).
- be written either in Portuguese or in English with, at most, 3500 words, including References and Appendices.

The submitted papers will be subjected to a review process by REM. Papers requiring an extensive reformulation or linguistic intervention will not be accepted for review.

Accepted pre-prints will be published in a section of the REM website.
